CFMP has 2 big picture items:

- 1) capacity needs, some facilities are under capacity and others are over,
- 2) future ready learning spaces and teaching practices.

CFMP Engagement Series #1, participation numbers are more than expected, survey remains open through Monday Sept 17th, over 3,800 surveys completed. Final plan for the Board of Education to decide, has not been determined. Lots of rumors but not any decisions, all conjecture (biggest reason for meetings). Outside firms/advisory groups hired to evaluate the data, present results and to guide process. Three engagement meetings planned, Sept, Oct, Nov. Engagement series #2 in October will present recommendations from planning and architecture partners/firms. Meetings week of October 8th. Engagement Series #3 in November will review refined recommendations. Meetings week of November 5th.
